DISAPPOINTED BY THE TEQUILAS AVAILABLE IN THE US MARKET, KRISTOPHER CREATED HIATUS TO SHOWCASE THE TRUE AGAVE FLAVOR IN TEQUILA.

THE BLANCO, REPOSADO, AND ANEJO EACH EXPRESS AGAVE IN A DIFFERENT LIGHT. BARREL INFLUENCE TAKES A BACK SEAT FOR ALL OF THE TEQUILAS AND THE PEPPERY AND EARTHY NOTES OF THIS PRECIOUS SUCCULENT TAKE FRONT STAGE. HIATUS TAKES A LOT OF PRIDE IN THE TRANSPARENCY OF THEIR PRODUCTION PROCESS TO SHOW THEY TRULY ARE PUTTING FORTH THE BEST PRODUCT POSSIBLE.

Haitus Reposado is rested 6 months in recycled American whiskey barrels, giving it a pale straw hue. Caramelized agave, roasted red pepper, and cinnamon notes give way to hazelnut and vanilla. Silky with a touch of sweetness, enjoy it on its own or in a premium cocktail.

DEL MAGUEY MEZCAL VIDA \$45

COUNTRY: MEXICO APPELLATION: MEZCAL

VIDA de San Luis Del Rio is an artisanal, Organic Mezcal from Del Maguey. Launched in 2010, it is highly mixable and has arrived to much anticipated industry acceptance and high bartender demand. Hand crafted, it is twice distilled, very slowly in small wood-fired, riverside copper stills to flavor specifications that underscore its versatility in cocktails. Another masterpiece out of San Luis del Rio, it has a nose of fruit aromatics, a hint of honey, vanilla and roast agave; the palate offers ginger, cinnamon, burnt sandalwood, banana and tangerine, with a long, soft finish.

DEL MAGUEY MEZCAL SAN LUIS RIO \$85

COUNTRY: MEXICO APPELLATION: MEZCAL

San Luis del Rio has a spicy, fruity and smoky nose with a high note of citrus. It is creamy, smooth and warming to the palate with a clean finish. Three hours south of Oaxaca on a two-lane, pot holed highway on route to the Gulf of Tehuantepec is the turnoff to San Luis del Rio. One takes another 2 hours on a winding, rocky, dirt road. The pueblo is located in a narrow, hot valley, with steep slopes full of Maguey Espadin. The Rio Hormiga Colorada (Red Ant River) flows through it. You may see Paciano Cruz Nolasco, tending his fields. Above the large fields of Maguey, the tops of the mountains are scattered with cornfields, Iguanas crawling across the road, the trees and cactus with Bromeliads growing on them.

Established in 1679, Eigashima was once considered among the top 100 corporations of the Meiji era of Japan. Now Eigashima is lovingly known as "Japan's Micro Distillery" having just recently hired their 7th full-time employee. Eigashima has been making sake and shochu with Japanese traditional craftsmanship since 1888, and as the first distillery to obtain a license to make whisky in Japan in 1919, is a true pioneer in its field. Known for its clean air and water, the city of Akashi is located in close proximMEZity to Kobe and is the only distillery in Japan situated closely to the sea. "With Honesty" as the company motto throughout the centuries, Eigashima's ninth generation leader, Mr. Hiraishi has uncompromising standards for each drop of his beautiful products.

HOW DOES IT TASTE?

This drinks like a hybrid of a bourbon and whiskey. Soft notes of vanilla and caramel are followed by cinnamon, chocolate, toffee and tobacco. For those who have not had much experience with Japanese whiskey, this is a great start as the flavor profile will be very familiar to scotch and bourbon drinkers.
